



Reference Networks

Following the Review of the Disability Services Act (1993) in 2002, the Disability Services Commission (the Commission) established Reference Networks to gain input from consumers on matters pertaining to service delivery and the Commission.

The role of the Reference Networks is to increase communication between the disability sector and the Board of the Commission. It is a formal mechanism where, people with disability, their families and carers, service providers and key community groups are able to raise matters for the Board's consideration and to also have input on matters currently being addressed by the Board that relate to service delivery and the Commission.

The metropolitan/central meetings are held periodically, usually at the Disability Services Commission, 146–160 Colin Street, West Perth.

The Commission Board also visits country locations and Reference Network meetings are arranged to coincide with the visits.
