



WA National Disability Insurance Scheme

Am I Eligible?

The NDIS began rolling out across Western Australia from 1 July 2017. All eligible people will have access to the scheme by 2020.

To participate in the NDIS, people with disability (including psychosocial disability) need to meet certain eligibility requirements. These are based on age, residence and either disability or early intervention requirements and are the same across Australia.

Age requirements

You need to be aged less than 65 years at the time of your eligibility request to participate in the NDIS.

Residence requirements

To be eligible for the NDIS you need to be:

- an Australian citizen or the holder of a permanent visa or a protected Special Category Visa (subclass 444); and
- permanently residing in an area where the NDIS operates.

Disability or early Intervention requirements

You meet the disability requirements for the NDIS if you have a disability that:

- is attributable to an intellectual, cognitive, neurological, sensory or physical impairment or to one or more impairments attributable to a psychiatric condition; **and**
- the impairment or impairments are, or are likely to be, permanent; **and**
- you are likely to require support for your lifetime.

Alternatively, you meet the early intervention requirements if you:

- have one or more identified intellectual, cognitive, neurological, sensory or physical

- impairments that are, or are likely to be, permanent; or
- have one or more identified impairments that are attributable to a psychiatric condition and are, or are likely to be, permanent; or
- are a child who has developmental delay.

Do you live in the Perth Hills?

From 1 July 2017, the WA NDIS commenced in the Perth Hills and surrounding areas (the local government areas of Swan, Kalamunda, Mundaring, Bayswater, Bassendean, Chittering, Toodyay, Northam and York) for eligible people with disability who are not currently connected to the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA).

People with disability who are not connected with the NDIA are encouraged to contact their local office to test their eligibility with the WA NDIS:
