Operating for 35 years within WA, our mission is to create opportunities for young people with disability to develop friendships, skills and self-confidence. Cahoots services include:

## **Camps**

Our exciting and rewarding camps, offer an opportunity to make new friends and try new activities in a fun supportive environment. During the school holidays, Cahoots offer 5-6 day camps travelling to locations around WA and during the school term weekend camps are held in Perth.

Activities include swimming, sports, bush walking, movies, trampolining, laser tag and much more! Camps are available for children aged 5-17 years, young adults aged 18+ and participants with complex needs and require 1:1 care/supervision.

#### **Social Rec Club**

A weekend day program which aims to expose children (aged 5-17years) to a variety of different sports and recreation activities in an encouraging, fun and safe environment. Sessions take at two locations (Success and Subiaco) every weekend for eight weeks of every school term.

#### Social Club 18+

Running once per month, Social Club 18+ gives young adults an opportunity to catch up socially for a meal, movie or fun activity.

Each camp/program, is run with the help of an experienced facilitator, along with a team of volunteer support leaders who are caring, enthusiastic and dedicated to making it an engaging and rewarding experience.
