The Fremantle Multicultural Centre has a commitment to providing an NDIS in WA service to CALD communities in the Rockingham/Mandurah areas focussing on consumers with a psychosocial disability.

The NDIS in WA services that we seek to provide is based on an understanding of culture and developing and implementing culturally competent and appropriate services to multicultural consumers and communities.

The NDIS in WA services that the Fremantle Multicultural Centre – Choice4me supports are based around assistance with everyday activities and life skills to enable individuals to live autonomously as possible.

The one-on-one support focus on daily personal activities around self-care and supporting social skills development, communication, using public transport independently and improving problem solving skills.

The services provided also supports participation in community, recreational and educational activities. The service also provides one-on-one supports, advice and coordination for CALD clients to seek educational opportunities available to them to improve access to employment.

There are one-on-one supports and assistance for individuals to pursue and participate in community, civic and social activities. There is also supports which has a focus on providing carers with opportunity to take a break during the day to undertake family activities or just to take a break and pursue self - care opportunities.
