The Neurological Council's service description:

The Neurological Council of WA has established a model of support that is designed to assist clients who present with behaviours associated with, or arising from, a neurological condition with potential to impact on their capacity.

Specialised assessment skills, abilities and competency to provide:

- Behaviour and neurological symptom assessment involving the clients, families and/or advocate.
- Development of a strength based behaviour support plan to address behaviour and neurological symptomology meeting the client's goal(s).
- Support, advocacy and/or development to implement a strength-based behaviour plan, i.e. service providers, clients, their families, carers and/or advocates, available via community neurological nurse and lifestyle adviser.
- Guide and support the establishment of collaborate relationships, and the provision of support, access to key specialists, services or support groups that assist in meeting the client's goals.
