WA NDIS: Perth Metropolitan Support Cluster and Price Framework

About the Support Cluster and Price Framework

The Perth Metropolitan Support Cluster and Price Framework (Perth Metropolitan SCPF) will see the Disability Services Commission (Commission) contract under eight global outcomes, as reflected by the eight clusters. Disability sector organisations will be able to deliver all strategies and activities that come under each cluster (outcome) they are contracted for.

The price ranges in the Perth Metropolitan SCPF replace previous contracted prices.

Where does it apply?

The Perth Metropolitan SCPF applies to the entire Perth metropolitan region (including the Cockburn-Kwinana WA NDIS area) but not the NDIA trial site (Hills).

Who does it apply to?

The Perth Metropolitan SCPF applies to individuals in receipt of Commission individualised funding living in the Perth metropolitan area.

When does it apply?

The Perth Metropolitan SCPF applies as at 1 July 2016. The timing of the actual application per individual plan post July 1 2016 will differ.

An individual's plan is required to be costed against the Perth Metropolitan SCPF in instances where an individual experiences the following on or after the 1 July 2016:

- Develops an initial WA NDIS plan;
 - Develops an initial plan with a Local Coordinator (previous Local Area Coordinator and/or My Way Coordinator);
 - Undertakes a scheduled annual review;
 - Undertakes an unscheduled review for increased or decreased support needs;
 - Changes service provider(s);
 - Engages Options Exploration to plan using individual funding.
- Services commence on or after 1 July 2016; even though the plan is completed before that date.
