Support to live your life

There is a new type of service called the WA National Disability Insurance Scheme (WA NDIS). This gives people with disability more choices about their support.

Who can get WA NDIS support?

You can use the NDIS if you:

- have a disability that affects your everyday life
- are younger than 65 years old
- live in the local government areas of Armadale, Serpentine-Jarrahdale, Murray, Cockburn, Kwinana or the Lower South West.

What can WA NDIS do for me?

You can get support to:

- care for yourself and your family
- do jobs around the house
- go to work and school
- go out and about.

You can get ongoing support even if things change

Talk to a Local Coordinator about what you might need and they will be there for you if things change.

Who are Local Coordinators?

Local Coordinators work for the Disability Services Commission. Local Coordinators will talk privately with you so you can get the support you need.
